Reporting a Student Absence - To report your child absent we have a Safe Arrival program. These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time. You can use one of the following:

- Option 1: Download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store. The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- Option 2: Use the SafeArrival website, https://www.sd33.bc.ca/safearrival. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- Option 3: Call the toll-free number 1-833-698-6567 to report an absence using the automated phone system.

HUB - Some changes will be made as we continue to allow everyone access to the resources they need. Changes are:

- **Hub Hours:** Open daily at drop off & pick up. Food Pantry only from Tuesday-Thursday. Fridays will be reserved to clear out any remaining food items.
- Food Deliveries: All delivery items will be available on TUESDAYS. no new food will arrive after until the next week.
- Pantry Access: Families will be limited to one visit per week. Fridays will be open for anyone to come back and pick up any left over items.
